
Dear Ms. Behun:

In am in receipt of your Procedural Order dated September 13, 1999 ordering a hearing at the offices of t he Arizona Corporation Commission for Monday, December 6, 1999 at 9:30 a.m. and find myself in a regrettable situation.

I wish to accommodate you and I am willing to help in any area I can because, as you can imagine, just how devastated my family and I are, knowing now we are victims of an alleged fraudulent scheme. My problem being, is I have no means of transportation to Phoenix. I was forced to sell my car for I have no money or credit cards. I am 80 years old and under doctor's care for a heart condition and emphysema. I must take oxygen almost 24 hours a day, and must use a nebulizer with albuterol medication three times a day. This also compounds the problem of traveling to Phoenix to your office for our meeting on October 13, 1999 at 10:00 a.m., not to mention the financial burden of spending the night in Phoenix. Under the circumstances, I was hoping that it might be possible to have someone come to Sierra Vista, or possibly do the interview telephonically.

I would be most grateful for anything you might be able to arrange. I will look forward to hearing from you soon.
