

PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

23 On February 27, 2002, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation
24 Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order
25 for Relief ("Notice") against Netgo, Inc. ("Netgo"), SDIC Partnership ("SDIC"), M-Corp.
26 International, M-Corp. International, LTD., Camelback, LTD., Neil David Lewis and Norman
27 Michael Miller, (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of

1 the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of
2 investment contracts.

3 Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

4 On March 6, 2002, Respondent Neil Lewis filed a request for hearing.

5 On March 12, 2002, Respondents Netgo and SDIC filed a request for hearing.

6 On April 3, 2002, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

7 On April 18, 2002, the pre-hearing conference was held and counsel for Respondent Norman
8 Miller appeared indicating that he also desired a hearing. During the pre-hearing conference, the
9 issues raised in the Notice, the length of the hearing and scheduling of the proceeding were discussed.
10 The parties indicated that they were attempting to reach a settlement in the proceeding and that, due
11 to scheduling conflicts, they agreed that the proceeding should not be scheduled for hearing for at
12 least 120 days allowing time for the negotiation and presentation of proposed Consent Orders for
13 Commission approval.

14 Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled on the allegations contained in the Notice after
15 September 1, 2002, to allow time for the negotiation of Consent Orders to be approved by the
16 Commission and to avoid scheduling conflicts.

17 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a hearing shall commence on September 9, 2002 at
18 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall set aside September 10, 11, 12, 17, 18 and
20 19, 2002 for additional days of hearing, if necessary.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange pre-marked witness and exhibit
22 lists by 4:00 p.m. on August 23, 2002 with a courtesy copy to be provided to the presiding
23 Administrative Law Judge.
