**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

22  
23 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

24 On February 27, 2002, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation  
25 Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order  
26 for Relief ("Notice") against Netgo, Inc. ("Netgo"), SDIC Partnership ("SDIC"), M-Corp.  
27 International, M-Corp. International, LTD., Camelback, LTD., Neil David Lewis and Norman  
28 Michael Miller, (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of

1 the Arizona Securities Act (“Act”) in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of  
2 investment contracts.

3 Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

4 On March 6, 2002, Respondent Neil Lewis filed a request for hearing.

5 On March 12, 2002, Respondents Netgo and SDIC filed a request for hearing.

6 On April 3, 2002, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

7 On April 18, 2002, the pre-hearing conference was held and counsel for Respondent Norman  
8 Miller appeared indicating that he also desired a hearing. During the pre-hearing conference, the  
9 issues raised in the Notice, the length of the hearing and scheduling of the proceeding were discussed.  
10 The parties indicated that they were attempting to reach a settlement in the proceeding and that, due  
11 to scheduling conflicts, they agreed that the proceeding should not be scheduled for hearing for at  
12 least 120 days allowing time for the negotiation and presentation of proposed Consent Orders for  
13 Commission approval.

14 On April 22, 2002, by Procedural Order, the proceeding was scheduled for hearing on  
15 September 9, 2002.

16 On August 23, 2002, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate Hearing (“Motion”) indicating that  
17 all parties that had requested a hearing have agreed to Consent Orders which are to be submitted to  
18 the Commission for approval.

19 Accordingly, the Division’s Motion should be granted and the hearing continued. In the event  
20 that any or all of the Consent Orders are not approved by the Commission, the Division should  
21 request the matter be rescheduled.

22 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Securities Division’s Motion to Vacate is hereby  
23 granted and the hearing scheduled for September 9, 2002 is vacated.

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2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Securities Division shall file a Motion to Reset Hearing  
3 if any of the Consent Orders are not approved by the Commission.
