PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 19, 2006, Hassayampa Utilities Company ("Hassayampa" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide wastewater service to the Hassayampa Ranch development in Maricopa County, Arizona ("Application").

On October 19, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued an insufficiency letter.

On October 21, 2005 and January 10, 2006, Hassayampa filed responses to Staff's insufficiency letter.

On March 27, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a sufficiency letter.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** in the above-captioned matter shall commence on **June 29, 2006 at 10:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") shall file a Staff Report on or before **May 26, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant and any intervenors shall file any objections to the Staff Report by **June 9, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105,

1 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **May 26, 2006**.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall provide public notice of the hearing in
3 this matter, in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 10 point bold type and
4 the body in no less than 10 point regular type:

9 On September 19, 2005, Hassayampa Utilities Company ("Applicant") filed with the
10 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of
11 Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide wastewater service to the
12 Hassayampa Ranch Development, located west of the Town of Buckeye and
13 approximately three miles north of Interstate 10, within Maricopa County, Arizona. If the
14 Application is granted, the Applicant would be the exclusive provider of wastewater to
15 this area, and would be required by the Commission to provide service under rates and
16 charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission.

17 The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of
18 the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and at
19 the offices of the Company, [*insert address*] and on the internet via the Commission
20 website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

21 The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning **June 29, 2006 at 10:00**
22 **a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.
23 Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

24 The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances,
25 interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by
26 law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons
27 desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which
28 motion should be sent to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record, and
which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or their counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **May 26, 2006**. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any person with interest in this proceeding from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf. You will not, however, receive any further notice of the

proceeding unless requested by you.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting Linda Hogan, ADA Coordinator, voice phone number 602/542-3931, E-mail lhogan@azcc.gov. Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall cause the above notice to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in its service territory, with publication to be completed no later than **April 29, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall mail to each property owner in the requested service territory a copy of the above notice by **April 29, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall file certification of publication/ mailing as soon as practicable after the publication/ mailing has been completed but not later than **May 5, 2006**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon publication/ mailing of same, notwithstanding the failure of an individual property owner to read or receive the notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


