EMERGENCY APPLICATION

OnSite Access Local, LLC ("OnSite" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Rule 14-2-1107 of the Arizona Administrative Code, hereby respectfully requests that the Commission grant OnSite, as soon as possible due to OnSite's distressed financial condition, authority to: (1) discontinue the provision of telecommunications services in Arizona; (2) abandon its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") within the state; and (3) revoke its tariff. OnSite is currently experiencing financial distress and has filed for bankruptcy protection. It is important to note that OnSite does not have any customers in the state, and no members of the general public in the state would be harmed by OnSite's withdrawal from the Arizona telecommunications market. Therefore, OnSite requests waiver of any applicable hearing, publication, and/or notice requirements, and requests expedited consideration of its application so that it may discontinue service **no later than August 15, 2001**.

In support of its Application, OnSite provides the following information:

I. APPLICANT

OnSite is a New York limited liability company headquartered in New York City. OnSite is authorized to provide resold and/or facilities-based interexchange and local exchange telecommunications service in various states. In Arizona, OnSite is authorized to provide resold

and facilities-based local and interexchange telecommunications service pursuant to a CC&N issued in Docket No. T-03881A-00-0350. OnSite only provides service to commercial customers, and does not have any residential subscribers.

III. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO DISCONTINUE SERVICE, ABANDON CERTIFICATE, AND REVOKE TARIFF

OnSite respectfully requests Commission approval to discontinue the provision of telecommunications services, abandon its CC&N, and revoke its tariff in Arizona. Due to adverse developments in the telecommunication industry, OnSite has filed for bankruptcy protection, and has determined that it must discontinue operations in Arizona as soon as possible. In the states in which it has customers, OnSite will notify its subscribers of its intention to cease operations, and will assist its customers to transition their service to other carriers. To ensure the smooth transfer of each customer, OnSite has developed a customer notification and transfer plan that is intended to provide the greatest opportunity for customer awareness, the informed

exercise of customer choice, and a seamless transition with no service interruption to the customers' selected carriers. OnSite customers will receive adequate written notices regarding the discontinuance of OnSite service and the need to elect a new service provider. However as noted above, OnSite does not have any customers in the state, and requests authority to discontinue service, abandon its CC&N, and revoke its tariff as soon as possible.


IV. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED PROCESSING

OnSite's withdrawal from the telecommunications services market in Arizona is necessary and reasonable given the company's dire financial situation, and will not adversely affect the public convenience and necessity. The public will not be unduly harmed by OnSite's withdrawal because other telecommunications carriers have the ability to provide these customers with comparable telecommunications services at competitive prices. OnSite is undertaking a comprehensive customer notification initiative that is aimed at providing its customers with sufficient notice and opportunity to select another provider and minimize service interruptions. Moreover, no harm will be caused to the general public in Arizona because the company does not serve any customers in the state.

V. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission authorize it to discontinue telecommunications services, abandon its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, and cancel its tariff as described herein. Further, the Applicant respectfully requests that this authorization be granted on an expedited basis to allow OnSite to complete its withdrawal from the Arizona market **no later than August 15, 2001.**
