12 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

13 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the  
14 Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

15 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

16 1. On September 18, 2000, in Decision No. 62895, the Commission granted to Onsite  
17 Access Local, LLC. ("Onsite" or "Applicant") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N")  
18 authorizing it to provide competitive interLATA/intraLATA reseller telecommunications services in  
19 Arizona.

20 2. On July 2, 2001, Onsite filed in this docket an application requesting that the  
21 Commission cancel its CC&N ("Application"). The Application stated that Onsite does not have any  
22 Arizona customers and had never offered telecommunication services in the state.

23 3. On May 24, 2002, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff  
24 Report in this matter.

25 4. In the Staff Report, Staff stated that Onsite had never offered telecommunications  
26 service in Arizona and there no prepayments, deposits, or advances that would be at risk by  
27 cancellation of Onsite's CC&N.

28 5. There are numerous other carriers in Arizona offering services similar to those Onsite

1 is currently certificated to provide.

2 6. No Arizona customers will be affected by the requested cancellation.

3 7. In the Staff Report, Staff recommended approval of Onsite's Application, without a  
4 hearing.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the  
7 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

8 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Applicant and the subject matter of the  
9 application.

10 3. The cancellation of Applicant's CC&N is in the public interest.

11 4. Staff's recommendation in Findings of Fact No. 7 is reasonable and should be  
12 adopted.

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**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Onsite Access Local, LLC for the cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive interLATA/intraLATA reseller telecommunications services in Arizona is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
