Dear Sir or Madam:

U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a/ TelePacific Communications ("TelePacific") was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CC&N) to provide competitive facilities-based and resold interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in Arizona by Decision No. 63446, dated March 13, 2001, in Docket No. T-03876A-00-0306. TelePacific has neither served Arizona customers under its Arizona CC&N nor accepted any prepaid advances or deposits. Attached is a verification from Jane Z. Delahanty, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, for TelePacific, confirming TelePacific's lack of customers in Arizona.

Due to a revised business plan, TelePacific does not intend to exercise its authority to provide services under its CC&N in the State of Arizona. Consequently, TelePacific requests that the Commission cancel its CC&N effective December 31, 2001.

TelePacific further requests a waiver of the A.A.C. R14-2-1107 requirement to provide legal notice and a list of alternative utilities because TelePacific serves no customers under the CC&N and no customers are impacted by this request for cancellation.


