Customer or subscriber - The person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders service and is responsible for payment of charges due and compliance with the company's tariff regulations.

Rule 1 - Definitions This applies to Premier Dial One and Excel Commercial 800 Service Customers.

Day: Denotes 8 a.m. to 4:59 p.m. local time at the originating terminal on Monday through Friday, excluding national holidays.

Evening: Denotes 5 p.m. to 10:59 p.m. local time at the originating terminal everyday of the week, and 8:00 a.m. to 4:59 p.m. on Holidays.

Night/  
Weekend: Denotes 11 p.m. to 7:59 a.m. local time at the originating terminal on Sunday through Friday, and 8 a.m. til 4:59 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Rule 1.1 - Definitions This applies to all Excel Plus Customers.

Day: Denotes 7 a.m. to 5:59 p.m. local time at the originating terminal on Monday through Friday, excluding national holidays.

Evening: Denotes 6 p.m. to 10:59 p.m. local time at the originating terminal on Monday through Friday, 5:00 p.m. to 10:59 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, and 7:00 a.m. to 5:59 p.m. Monday through Friday on Holidays.

Night/  
Weekend: Denotes 11 p.m. to 6:59 a.m. local time at the originating terminal everyday of th week, and 7:00 a.m. to 4:59 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

Rule 1.2 - Definitions This applies to all My 800 and Excel Cellular Customers.

Day: Denotes 7 a.m. to 5:59 p.m. local time at the originating terminal on Monday through Friday, excluding national holidays.

Evening: Denotes 6 p.m. to 6:59 a.m. local time at the originating terminal every day of the week, and 7:00 a.m. to 5:59 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday and holidays.

Holidays - Excel Telecommunications, Inc.,'s, Evening rate applies tot the following holidays:

**3.3.2 Travel Card Service**

Customers are issued a Travel Card imprinted with a 1+ 800 toll free number which may be used to access Excel's long distance network.

**3.3.3 Directory Assistance**

Local exchange directory assistance operators may be accessed by dialing 0+ 555-1212, or 0+ (xxx)555-1212.

**3.3.4 MY 800:**

My 800 is a one-way, dial in service allowing the customer to receive calls via local exchange carrier access facilities. My 800 permits calls to a customer's station in one location from stations in diverse geographical service areas, and in which the My 800 customer is billed for the calls rather than the call originators. Customers may use My 800 only in Equal Access areas. All calls will be rounded up to the next whole minute for billing purposes.

**3.3.5 Excel Cellular**

Excel Cellular is a one-way, dial in-dial out multipoint service allowing the customer to originate calls from their cellular phones via their cellular provider and terminate calls via local exchange carrier access facilities. Customers may access Excel Cellular only in Equal Access areas. All calls will be rounded up to the next whole minute for billing purposes.

**3.3.6 Excel Plus**

Excel Plus is a one-way, dial in-dial out multipoint service allowing the customer to originate and terminate calls via local exchange carrier access facilities. Customers may access Excel Plus only in Equal Access areas. Alls calls will be rounded up to the next whole minute for billing purposes. If a subscriber to this service calls another Excel Plus customer then the call originator will save 20% per minute for the duration of the call.

**3.3.7 Premier Dial One Commercial Service**

Premier Dial One Commercial Service is a one-way, dial in-dial out multipoint service allowing the customer to originate and terminate calls vial local exchange carrier access facilities. Customers may subscribe to this service only in Equal Access areas. All calls less than one-half minute in length will be rounded up to one-half minute for billing purposes. All calls in excess of one-half minute in length will be rounded up to the next one-tenth minute for billing purposes.

## 3.3.8 Excel Commercial 800 Service

Excel Commercial 800 Service is a one-way, dial in service allowing the customer to receive calls via local exchange carrier access facilities. Excel Commercial 800 Service permits calls to a customer's station in one location from stations in diverse geographical service areas, and in which the Excel Commercial 800 Service customer is billed for the calls rather than the call originators. Customers may use this service in Equal Access areas only. All calls will be billed in 6 second increments after the first full minute for billing purposes.

4.2 Travel Card calls

Customers are issued a Travel Card imprinted with a 1 + 800 toll free telephone number which may be used to access Excel's long distance network. Calls completed by this method will be charged at the following rate, regardless of the time of day or date completed:

For the first minute or part thereof: \$0.89  
 For each minute thereafter, or part thereof: \$0.29

4.2.1 Excel Commercial 800 Service Rate:

The effective rate for this service will be a flat rate of .2500 per minute for all times.

4.2.2 800 Volume Discount Rates:

As the total long distance usage increases, simultaneously so does the volume discount. To reiterate, the more usage used per month, the more savings incurred.
