PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 10, 2001, Red Rock Water Cooperative, Inc. ("Red Rock" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for adjudication that it is not a public service corporation under Arizona law.

On November 9, 2001, a Procedural Order was issued in this matter setting the matter for hearing and requiring public notice of the application to be provided to each property owner in the requested adjudication area.

On November 19, 2001, Applicant filed its Certification of Mailing verifying that notice of the application and the hearing had been mailed to all property owners in the requested adjudication area.

On January 11, 2002, the Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter recommending that the Commission adjudicate Applicant not a public service corporation.

A hearing on the application was held as scheduled on February 5, 2002 before a duly authorized Administrative Law Judge of the Commission. Applicant and Staff appeared through counsel and presented evidence. At the close of the hearing, the matter was taken under advisement.

On May 21, 2002 a Proposed Opinion and Order was issued in this docket. At the Commission's June 4, 2002 Open Meeting the Commission considered, but did not vote on, the Proposed Opinion and Order.

It is necessary to hold a procedural conference for the parties to discuss the procedural posture of this case.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a procedural conference shall be held in this matter on  
2 **June 13, 2002 at 1:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200  
3 W. Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
5 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's  
6 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
8 any portion of this Procedural Order.


