

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE
APPLICATION OF RED ROCK WATER
COOPERATIVE, INC. FOR ADJUDICATION
THAT IT IS NOT A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY**

On October 10, 2001, Red Rock Water CoOperative, Inc. ("Red Rock") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for adjudication that it is not a public service corporation under Arizona law. If Red Rock is adjudicated not to be a public service corporation, Red Rock will not be required by the Commission to provide service under rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and at the offices of the Company, c/o Steven R. Owens, Esq., 25 Bell Rock Plaza, Suite A, Sedona, Arizona 86351-8804.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning February 5, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the meeting.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or it's counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before December 19, 2001. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any potential customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf. You will not, however, receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting Shelly Hood, ADA Coordinator, voice phone number 602/542/3931, E-mail shood@cc.state.az.us. Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation.
