PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order issued June 17, 2002, a hearing was scheduled to commence on September 9, 2002 regarding the issues raised by the City of Litchfield Park's ("City") Exceptions to the May 21, 2002 Opinion and Order. The Procedural Order also established certain other dates regarding discovery and filing of testimony.

On June 21, 2002, the Applicant in this case, Litchfield Park Service Company ("LPSCO"), filed a letter requesting that several of the dates be changed. LPSCO states that it was previously unaware that one of its witnesses is unavailable on the September 9, 2002 hearing date. LPSCO represents that all of the other parties have agreed to the following revised dates:

Direct Testimony by City	August 14, 2002
Rebuttal Testimony	August 21, 2002
Surrebuttal Testimony	August 28, 2002
Procedural Conference	September 3, 2002
Hearing	September 4, 2002

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing on issues raised by the City's Exceptions shall commence on September 4, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a procedural conference shall be held on September 3, 2002, at 10:00 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that final discovery requests shall be served by no later than July 29, 2002, and responses to discovery requests shall be completed within 7 calendar days from service.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City's direct testimony shall be filed by August 14,
2 2002.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rebuttal testimony shall be filed by August 21, 2002.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that surrebuttal testimony shall be filed by August 28, 2002.


