RE: IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF CC&N FROM WINSTAR WIRELESS OF ARIZONA TO WINSTAR WIRELESS, INC. DUE TO MERGER (DOCKET NOS. T-03023A-98-0719 AND T-03670A-98-0719)

On December 17, 1998, Winstar Wireless Inc. ("Winstar") filed an application to transfer its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") from Winstar Wireless of Arizona, Inc. ("Company") to Winstar Wireless, Inc. due to a merger under Docket Nos. T-03023A-98-0719 and T-03670A-98-0719.

On March 5, 2002, Winstar Wireless of Arizona, Inc. changed its name to Winstar Communications of Arizona, LLC. According to Decision No. 65649, Winstar Communications of Arizona, LLC's CC&N was revoked on February 18, 2003. Their CC&N was revoked because they failed to file their 2001 Utilities Division Annual Report with the Commission. As a result, the Company does not have a CC&N.

Since the Company does not have a CC&N, there is no certificate that can be transferred to Winstar. Staff recommends that this application be terminated and that Docket Nos. T-03023A-98-0719 and T-03670A-98-0719 be administratively closed.
