14 On June 3rd, 1999, Sun City Water Company and Sun City West Utilities
15 Company (collectively referred to as "Sun City Companies") requested that the
16 Hearing Division issue a procedural order in the above captioned docket. As part
17 of that request, the Sun City companies suggested a procedural schedule.

18 On June 11th, 1999, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") and
19 Commission Staff each filed responses to the Sun City Companies' request.
20 Neither of these parties objected to the scheduling of a hearing; instead, each
21 proposed a different procedural schedule.

22 The Sun City Companies have no objection to the proposed dates of either
23 party. However, the Sun City Companies are more comfortable with the RUCO
24 proposed schedule, because it sets a firm hearing date. It is crucial that the
25 Commission makes a determination on this matter in a timely fashion, so the
26 Sun City Companies can implement the use of Central Arizona Project Water by
27 December 31, 2000.
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1 In conclusion, the Sun City Companies request that the Hearing Officer
2 issue a procedural order to govern this proceeding and to set a hearing date.
