AECC Late-Filed Exhibit No. 8

AECC was asked to clarify whether certain coal-plant cost savings experienced by APS that were discussed in the hearing are included in AECC's calculations in AECC Exhibit No. 7. Based on discussions with APS, AECC concludes that the coal-plant cost-savings are accounted for in the calculations shown in AECC Exhibit No. 7, and appear as part of the \$41 million net increase in Palo Verde outage costs. That is, it is AECC's understanding that the coal-plant-related savings are reducing what would otherwise be a higher Palo Verde outage cost.
