PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 17, 2006, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application and approval of interconnection agreement with AzCom Paging, Inc., Smith Bagley Inc., Handy Page, AnswerPhone Inc., Star Page Inc., Glen Canyon Communications Inc., Nextel West Corp., Western Wireless Corporation, Tele-Page, Inc., Westsky Wireless, L.L.C. and Pac West Telecomm Inc. (collectively "Carriers").

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act"), the Commission must act on the request within 120 days, in this case, by July 11, 2006.

On March 29, 2006, a procedural conference was held as scheduled. The only parties that appeared at the procedural conference were Qwest and Handy Page. According to Qwest's counsel and Handy Page's representative, Western Wireless Corporation, Smith Bagley, Inc., and Handy Page are currently dealing with Qwest, whether to negotiate or to determine whether an interconnection agreement is possible based on the services provided by the companies in Arizona.

1 Qwest stated that the remaining parties¹ have failed to respond to Qwest's attempt to
2 negotiate. Pursuant to 47 USC § 251(c)(1), the parties in this matter have a duty to negotiate in good
3 faith with one another the particular terms and conditions of agreements to fulfill the duties
4 prescribed in 47 USC § 251(b).

5 Pursuant to 47 USC § 252(b)(3), non-petitioning parties have until the 25th day after the
6 Commission receives the petition to respond to the filing. In this case, the Carriers are the non-
7 petitioning parties and have until April 11, 2006 to file a response to Qwest's Application.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, should the parties fail to come to agreement through
9 voluntary negotiations between themselves, the non-petitioning parties shall file a response in this
10 docket no later than April 11, 2006.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs to transcribe the proceedings shall be borne
12 equally by Qwest and the Carriers.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 33(c) and (d) of the
14 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
16 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
17 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to
18 appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter
19 is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by
20 the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.
