**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On May 15, 2002, a Recommended Opinion and Order was issued in this matter.

On May 28, 2002, the Sun City Taxpayers Association ("SCTA") and Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed Exceptions to the Recommended Order.

By Procedural Order issued May 31, 2002, interested parties were directed to file responses to the SCTA and RUCO Exceptions to the Recommended Opinion and Order by no later than June 7, 2002.

By Procedural Order issued June 6, 2002, Arizona-American Water Company's ("Arizona-American") request for an extension of time to file its response, until June 14, 2002, was granted.

On June 14, 2002, Staff requested an additional extension of time for filing responses to the exceptions, until June 19, 2002. By Procedural Order issued June 17, 2002, Staff's request was granted.

On June 18, 2002, counsel for Arizona-American contacted the Administrative Law Judge and verbally requested an additional two-day extension of time due to unexpected circumstances. Counsel for Arizona-American indicated that no party opposed the additional extension of time.
