It is disturbing to read that there will be another delay in approving the CAP pipeline into the Sun Cities which would decrease the pumping of groundwater in Sun City and Sun City West. This plan to use CAP water for irrigation purposes has been before the commission for years and yet, there is still no decision. We must curtail ground water pumping as soon as possible. Putting water into a recharge facility 7 miles away does not accomplish that end, since there is no assurance that the recharged water would replenish the Sun Cities aquifer any time soon, or ever. There is also the issue of subsidence which will continue to threaten our communities if ground water pumping is not reduced. I understand that the Arizona Department of Water Resources is in strong support of the pipeline option over any other plan.

Please vote in favor of the CAP pipeline plan as soon as possible, so that construction can begin before the pipeline project becomes even more costly.
