Dear Mr. Chantel:

I was recently given a copy (dated March 4, 2006) of the exceptions you filed regarding the February 28, 2006 Recommended Order and Opinion drafted by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Teena Wolfe. In response, I want to state clearly to you that I do not author recommended orders and opinions. I do not author legal briefs. I did not assign ALJ Wolfe to your case. I certainly did not remove her from it—she remains the ALJ of record on your complaint. The accusations you have made about me are, in a word, wrong.

I would appreciate you reconsidering and then retracting the false claims you have made. I would also continue to encourage you to refrain from making baseless accusations, launching personal attacks on Commissioners or Commission Staff, and issuing threatening/intimidating statements.
