STF 1.7 Per Applicant's answer to A-19, AmeriVon has authority or is seeking authority to provide telecommunications services in Washington, D.C. and all 50 states except Alaska, New York and Oklahoma. Please explain the exclusion of these states.

AmeriVon intends to provide telecommunications services in Washington, D.C. and the contiguous United States and Hawaii. The response to A-19 in AmeriVon's original application includes Oklahoma in the listing of states where applications are being filed. An application has also been filed in New York, which was inadvertently not included on the listing in the response.

AmeriVon does not intend to provide telecommunications services in Alaska.

STF 1.8 Please provide the decision number and associated date authorizing AmeriVon to provide service as a Long Distance Reseller in Utah, Washington, D.C. and Virginia.

The provision of long distance telecommunications services in Utah, Washington, D.C. and Virginia is deregulated and, as such, no authority need be sought before the Public Utility Commissions in these jurisdictions.

STF 1.9 Please clarify if AmeriVon LLC has any affiliates other than its parent, AmeriVon Holdings LLC.

STF 1.10 The Certificate of Good Standing included in AmeriVon's application is from the State of Nevada. Please provide a Certificate of Good Standing in Arizona from the State of Arizona.

A Certificate of Good Standing is being ordered from the Arizona Corporation Commission and AmeriVon will supplement this filing upon receipt of the Certificate.



**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE
COMPETITIVE RESOLD INTEREXCHANGE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES BY AMERIVON LLC**

AmeriVon LLC ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission.

A.R.S. § 40-282 provides that the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing, if one is requested by any party. Applicant or any other party must request a hearing within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice, or the Commission will rule on the application without a hearing.

The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the Staff report prepared by the Applicant are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at Applicant, located at 800 Southwood Boulevard, Suite 212, Incline Village, Nevada 89451..

Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings, and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with the A.A.C. R 14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice. You may have the right to intervene in the proceedings, or you may make a statement for the record. If you have any comments, mail them to:

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE AND RATES

3.6 Public Telephone Surcharge

In order to recover the Company's expenses to comply with the FCC's pay telephone compensation plan effective on October 7, 1997 (FCC 97-371), an undiscountable per call charge is applicable to all interstate, intrastate and international calls that originate from any domestic pay telephone used to access the Company's services. This surcharge, which is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service, applies for the use of the instrument used to access the Company service and is unrelated to the Company's service accessed from the pay telephone.

Pay telephones include coin-operated and coinless phones owned by local telephone companies, independent companies and other interexchange carriers. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge applies to the initial completed call and any reoriginated call (i.e., using the "#" symbol).

Whenever possible, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge will appear on the same invoice containing the usage charges for the surcharged call. In cases where proper pay telephone coding digits are not transmitted to the Company prior to completion of a call, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge may be billed on a subsequent invoice after the Company has obtained information from a carrier that the originating station is an eligible pay telephone.

The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge does not apply to calls placed from pay telephones at which the Customer pays for service by inserting coins during the progress of the call.
