ALLTEL Communications, Inc. ("ACI"), by and through undersigned counsel, hereby moves to further continue for a period of 120 days all deadlines in this matter and the hearing on its application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide competitive intrastate toll telecommunications services (the "Application").

On September 11, 2000, the Commission issued a Procedural Order setting a hearing date in this matter and deadlines for filing fair value rate base information.

On October 11, 2000, ACI filed a Motion to Continue Deadlines and Hearing, seeking to continue the hearing date and all deadlines for a period of 120 days. The reason for the requested continuance was (1) to give time for resolution of issues concerning the requirement that competitive carriers provide fair value rate base information and justify their rates based on that information; and (2) once fair value rate base issues are resolved, to allow ACI sufficient time to gather the information and prepare the necessary analyses.

On October 23, 2000, the Administrative Law Judge granted ACI's motion, and ordered all deadlines in this matter continued.

As of the filing of this motion, the fair value rate base issues have not been resolved. Those issues are the subject of a generic proceeding, Docket No. RT-00000D-00-0694. If those issues can be fully and partially resolved in this proceeding, ACI will be in a position to resume prosecution of its Application.

For the foregoing reasons, ACI requests that all deadlines set forth in the Procedural Order, and the date for the Hearing, be further continued for a period of 120 days.
