**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On October 11, 2000, ALLTEL Communications, Inc. ("Applicant") filed an Motion to Continue Deadlines and Hearing, requesting an extension of 120 days on all deadlines established in our September 11, 2000 Procedural Order. No party opposed the request. Applicant's request in reasonable and no party will be prejudiced thereby. Consequently, our September 11, 2000 Procedural Order is modified as set forth herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant shall file written exceptions, if any, to the Staff Report or request that a hearing be set within 150 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall file its proposed FVRB within 120 days of the date of this Order (pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103(B), this may be the same as original cost rate base). The FVRB shall include the value of all plant and equipment currently held by the Applicant and intended to be used to provide telecommunications services to Arizona customers. In doing so, Applicant may use any reasonable means of asset allocation, direct assignment or combination thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall file a description of all plant and equipment currently held by the Company and intended to be used to provide telecommunications services to Arizona customers, including their cost and location, within 120 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall file information demonstrating how the value of the Company's plant and equipment (both current and projected) is related to its total service

1 long-run incremental costs within 120 days of the date of this Order (such demonstration must  
2 include the amount of depreciation expense and capital carrying costs related to the FVRB which has  
3 been incorporated into the long-run incremental costs).

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for all maximum rates and charges of Applicant which are  
5 higher than those of the incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") for the same regulated services,  
6 Applicant must demonstrate that such rates and charges are not unreasonable, and constitute a fair  
7 rate of return on FVRB (if there is more than one ILEC in your proposed service area, use Qwest  
8 Corporation as a surrogate ILEC for the entire state).

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall review the FVRB information filed and ascertain  
10 that Applicant is utilizing the appropriate amount of depreciation and capital carrying costs in  
11 determining its total service long-run incremental costs.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff or Intervenors shall file disagreements with the  
13 proposed FVRB and/or rates and charges, as well as request a hearing, within 150 days of this Order.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
15 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive  
17 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
