Dear Mr. Bostwick:

On behalf of Big Planet, Inc. ("Big Planet" or the "Company"), this letter responds to your letter dated January 24, 2002 requesting that Big Planet provide certain fair value information in connection with its pending certificate application in Docket No. T-03630A-01-0854. Big Planet has operated a non-regulated telecommunications related business in Arizona since March 1999. Accordingly, the request calls for Big Planet to provide the following information:

- (1) **Provide the actual dollar amount representing the total revenue for the latest twelve months available to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers by the Applicant, adjusted to reflect the maximum rates that the Applicant has requested in its tariff. This adjusted total revenue figure could be calculated as the number of units sold for all services offered times the maximum charge per unit.**

Big Planet has generated total Arizona revenues of \$23,219 for the latest twelve months for all non-regulated telecommunications related services rendered by the Company.

- (2) **Provide the total actual operating expenses for the same twelve months as above to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers by the Applicant.**

Big Planet has not incurred any in-state operating expenses for the latest twelve month period to provide telecommunications related services to Arizona customers. All of Big Planet's operating expenses are incurred in the State of Utah and cannot be feasibly allocated to the operations of a particular state. As a close approximation,


however, Big Planet generally incurs a per state average overhead expense of thirty-one percent (31%) in generating in-state revenues.

- (3) Provide the book value (original cost less accumulated depreciation) of all Arizona jurisdictional assets used to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers at the end of the same twelve months as above. If the fair value of those assets is different than the original cost net book value, also provide the corresponding projected fair value amounts. Assets are not limited to plant and equipment. Items such as office equipment and office supplies should be included in this list. If the projected value of all assets is zero, please specifically state this in your response.**

Big Planet currently does not have any jurisdictional plant or equipment that is used to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers, nor has it had any such plant or equipment that has been used to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers for the latest twelve month period.
