Per the letter of John Bostwick dated January 8, 2002, the following are responses to the requests contained therein regarding Applicants that have not commenced operations in Arizona, submitted on behalf of Optical Telephone Corporation ("Optical"). Please find an original and eleven (11) copies of Optical's responses. Please acknowledge receipt of this filing by file stamping and returning the extra copy of this filing in the self-addressed, stamped envelope provided for this purpose.

1. *Provide the projected total revenue for the first twelve months to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers by the Applicant following certification, adjusted to reflect the **maximum rates** that the Applicant has requested in its tariff. This adjusted total revenue figure could be calculated as the number of units sold for all services offered times the maximum charge per unit.*

Optical projects its total revenue for its first twelve months of operation in Arizona to be approximately \$20,000.

2. *Provide the projected **operating expenses** for the first twelve months to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers by the Applicant following certification.*

Optical projects its operating expenses for its first twelve months of operation in Arizona to be approximately 30 percent of its total revenue, or \$6,000.

3. *Provide the book value (original cost less accumulated depreciation) of **all Arizona jurisdictional assets** projected to be providing telecommunications service to Arizona customers at the end of the first twelve months of operation. If the projected fair value of*

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those assets is different than the projected original cost net book value, also provide the corresponding projected fair value amounts. Assets are not limited to plant and equipment. Items such as office equipment and office supplies should be included in this list. If the projected value of all assets is zero, please specifically state this in your response.

Optical owns no Arizona jurisdictional assets. Consequently, the projected value of all Arizona jurisdictional assets is zero.
