PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 5, 2005, West End Water Company ("West End" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate").

On February 3, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Sufficiency.

On February 6, 2006, a procedural order was issued setting forth filing deadlines and a hearing date in this matter.

On March 28, 2006, the City of Surprise filed an Application for Leave to Intervene. There has been no opposition to the request to intervene. By procedural order, on April 18, 2006, the City of Surprise was granted intervention.

On April 19, 2006, the City of Surprise filed a Stipulation Regarding Testimony by Intervenor and Responses wherein it requested that the deadline for filing of intervenor testimony be extended to May 1, 2006, and the deadline for filing any responses by Applicant to intervenor testimony be extended to May 9, 2006. The City of Surprise stated in its filing that it has "conferred with and obtained consent from West End" regarding these proposed changes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that testimony by Intervenor shall be filed by May 1, 2006.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that responses by the Applicant, if any, to Intervenor testimony shall be filed no later than May 9, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other deadlines set forth in the February 6, 2006,

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
3 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
