On February 8, 2006, Cordia Communications Corp. ("Cordia") filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide telecommunication services in the State of Arizona. On March 1, 2006, the Corporation Commission responded to the Application with Staff's First Set of Data Request. On March 30, 2006, Applicant responded to Staff's First Set of Data Request. Upon review of your response, the application is not yet sufficient. This data request lists the information Staff needs to complete its analysis of your application. Please provide Docket Control with the information being requested within 30 days of the date of this letter. Please mail an original plus 13 copies to: Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007-2927. If no response is received or all deficiencies are not remedied within 30 days, Staff will recommend that the application be terminated pursuant to Rule R14-2-1103(B)3 and R14-2-510(E)3. If the


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application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide the same telecommunication services in Arizona for which it is currently applying, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.

Please make certain that each numbered item and each part of the item is answered completely. In order for Staff to continue with its review of this application, the following information must be submitted:

- STF 2.1 In Applicant's response to STF 1.12 requesting information on the Company's key personnel in the States where the Company currently operates, Applicant submitted a listing of its registered agents that accept service of process on behalf of the Company. This is not what was requested. Please provide a list of key personnel employed by Applicant in each State where the Company currently provides services. Key personnel have telecommunications work experience and are responsible for the daily operations of the Company in those authorized States. Indicate employee's name, title, position, description of work experience, and years of service in the telecommunications services industry.
- STF 2.2 Applicant did not provide the Docket Number of the filing of its interconnection agreement with Qwest; only the filing date of February 2, 2006. As originally requested by Staff, please provide the Arizona Corporation Commission Docket Number of the proceeding in which the resale agreement was approved.
- STF 2.3 Applicant indicated in its Response to STF 1.15 that it has entered into multi-state interconnection agreements with Verizon, AT&T and Qwest. As originally requested by Staff, please supplement this information with the number and types of interconnection agreements that the Company has entered into with these providers of services.
