PROCEDURAL ORDER

13 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

14 On December 23, 1999, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("Applicant" or "ICG") submitted to
15 Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a
16 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive facilities-based and
17 resold intrastate telecommunications services in Arizona.

18 On August 8, 2002, a procedural conference was held, and the matter was set for hearing on
19 October 24, 2002.

20 On October 7, 2002, the parties filed a joint motion to continue the hearing as Staff has
21 requested additional information from ICG.

22 Accordingly, the hearing should be rescheduled.

23 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in this matter set for October 24, 2002 shall
24 be continued until **January 7, 2003**, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 W.
25 Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall publish notice of its filing, as stated below,
27 in a newspaper(s) of general circulation in every county in Arizona in which Applicant desires to
28 provide service by **November 17, 2002**, and shall file Affidavits of Publication with the Commission
no later than **December 1, 2002**.

ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive facilities-based and resold local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission.

The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the applicant are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at Applicant, [address].

Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings and participate as a party. You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding, or you may make a statement for the record. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before December 15, 2002. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the company, a shareholder of the company, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

A.A.C. R14-3-105 shall govern the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. The hearing is scheduled to commence on **January 7, 2003 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.




