PROCEDURAL ORDER

10 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

11 On December 23, 1999, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("Applicant" or "ICG") submitted to  
12 Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a  
13 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive facilities-based and  
14 resold intrastate telecommunications services in Arizona.

15 On May 24, 2000 and July 5, 2000, ICG filed Amendments to its application.

16 On June 22, 2000, ICG filed Affidavits of Publication indicating compliance with the  
17 Commission's notice requirements.

18 On August 23, 2000, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff Report.

19 This matter was continued indefinitely, based upon ICG's indication that it will not enter the  
20 Arizona market until late 2002.

21 On January 14, 2002, ICG filed a Notice of Substitution of Counsel. The Notice indicated  
22 that the law firm of Roshka Heyman & DeWulf had been substituted as legal counsel in this matter in  
23 place of the law firm of Dickstein Shapiro Morin & Oshinsky.

24 On January 16, 2002, ICG filed a Status Report on its Application and requested that a  
25 Procedural Conference be held.

26 On January 31, 2002, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that set this matter for a  
27 Procedural Conference on March 12, 2002.

28 On March 12, 2002, the Procedural Conference was held as scheduled. Staff and ICG both

1 appeared with the assistance of counsel. At the status conference, ICG indicated it wished to proceed  
2 with its application and requested a hearing in this matter.

3 Accordingly, a hearing should be set in this matter.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Hearing in this matter shall be held on August 8,  
5 2002, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 W. Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.


6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall contact ICG by April 30, 2002 requesting the  
7 specific information it requires in order to process ICG's Application.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ICG shall respond to Staff's informational request no later  
9 than June 28, 2002.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file an amended Staff Report on or before July  
11 12, 2002.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
13 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
