STATUS REPORT

Applicant ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("ICG"), through undersigned counsel, hereby submits its status report on its application and its readiness for a hearing date to be set in this matter as follows:

On October 17, 2001, ICG filed with the Commission its "Update Concerning Status of Application" indicating that under its then current business plan, ICG's entry into the Arizona local exchange market would not be until late 2002 and requesting that a hearing date be scheduled on or after April 1, 2002.

On October 29, 2001, the Commission issued a Procedural Order that, among other things, required ICG to file another update to its application not later than April 2002. This status report is filed pursuant to that Procedural Order.

ICG presently intends to enter the Arizona local exchange market in 2002. ICG desires to proceed with its application and participate in the requisite hearings in order to obtain a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide competitive facilities-based and resold intrastate telecommunications services in Arizona.


