
Dear Mr. Lebreck,

Comm South Companies, Inc. ("Comm South") is a telecommunications carrier providing resold residential pre-paid local and long distance service in the State of Arizona (the "State") pursuant to a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, which was granted under Docket T-03466A-97-0636 on 11/19/1999 and T-03466A-00-0811 on 03/14/2001. In accordance with Section R14-2-1107 of the Arizona Administrative Code, Comm South submits the instant application for authorization to discontinue service and cancel its certificated authority to resell local exchange and interexchange services in the State. Comm South is in Chapter 7 bankruptcy protection and is in the process of liquidating its business and its assets, including discontinuing telecommunications service.

In accordance with the rules of the Federal Communications Commission and the Arizona Corporation Commission, Comm South sent the attached letter to its residential customers, notifying them that it will be discontinuing residential service in thirty days, effective October 9, 2005. Comm South provided residential services to 57 customers in the State at the time it sent the discontinuance notification letter (Comm South also provided service to a single pay telephone provider in the State). Comm South no longer has any customers, residence or business, in the State. The customer notification letter included a list of alternative CLEC, ILEC and long distance providers in the State. Notice of this application will be published in a newspaper having state-wide distribution in the State within 20 days of the date of this application, and a copy of the affidavit will be sent to the Arizona Corporation Commission as soon as available.

RE: **NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE OF PRE-PAID LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE SERVICE**

It has been our pleasure at Comm South Companies, Inc. to provide you with quality, pre-paid local and long distance services. We regret to inform you that as of October 9, 2005, Comm South Companies, Inc. ("Comm South") will no longer provide pre-paid local and long distance telephone service.

Your action is required! You must select a new local and/or long distance telephone provider to provide you with the same services you are currently receiving from Comm South as quickly as possible but no later than October 9, 2005. Please see the enclosed letter from dPi Teleconnect, LLC, one potential provider of pre-paid local and long distance services. Also enclosed is a list of local and long distance providers. You can also find a list of local and long distance telephone service providers in your local telephone directory.

As a pre-paid customer of Comm South, you are free to discontinue Comm South service at any time by simply not pre-paying Comm South for telephone service and choosing another provider. Pre-paid customers do not maintain deposits with Comm South.

After selecting a new local telephone provider, you should also contact your current long distance provider to ensure that your current long distance calling plan is not changed as a result of your change in your local service. If you do not contact your long distance provider, you may be charged basic rates (non-calling plan rates) for long distance calls. Of course, if you are receiving long distance services from Comm South, you must select a new long distance provider.

The Federal Communications Commission will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments within 15 days after receipt of this notification. Address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Washington, DC 20554, referencing the Section 63.71 Application of Comm South, Inc. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed

discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
