PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 3, 2004, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 67435 which granted to Lightyear Networks Solutions, LLC ("Lightyear") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold and facilities-based local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona with conditions.

On November 30, 2005, Lightyear filed a Petition for Modification of Performance Bond Condition or Alternatively for Extension of Time. There have been no filings since that time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff shall file an update on Lightyear Networks Solutions, LLC's request for modification with any appropriate recommendation no later than June 16, 2006.
