By Decision No. 65124, dated August 23, 2002, the Arizona Corporation Commission (the "Commission") granted to Xspedius Management Company Switched Services, LLC ("Xspedius") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive local exchange, interexchange and exchange access telecommunications service within the State of Arizona. As required by the Order, Xspedius hereby certifies the following:

- As required by ¶ 20(a) of the Order, American Communication Services, Inc. ("e.spire") has assigned and Xspedius has assumed the existing interconnection agreement between e.spire and Qwest Corporation.
- As required by ¶ 20(b) of the Order, Xspedius plans to have its customers' telephone numbers included in the incumbent's Directories and Directory Assistance databases pursuant to the identical directory assistance arrangements with Qwest Corporation as those formerly maintained by ACSI Local Switched Services, Inc., d/b/a e.spire under the interconnection agreement.

- As required by ¶ 20(g) of the Order, Xspedius has resolved all issues regarding the provision of 911 service with the appropriate emergency service provider.
