PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 15, 2001, Tri-M Communications, Inc. d.b.a. TMC Communications ("Applicant" or "Tri-M") submitted to Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive intrastate facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services statewide.

On December 6, 2001, Applicant filed an amendment to its application, expanding the scope of authority requested to include resold local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services.

Applicant is required to publish notice of its filing in all counties where service is to be provided. On January 22, 2002, Tri-M filed an affidavit of publication verifying that notice of Tri-M's application was published in the Arizona Republic on January 14, 2002. The published notice provided instructions on intervention, and required that all motions to intervene be filed within 20 days of the date of the notice. No motions to intervene have been filed.

On April 23, 2002, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff Report on the application. Accordingly, the matter should be set for hearing.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing on the application shall commence on **June 18, 2002 at 2:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West

1 Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall pre-file specific disagreements and
3 comments on the Staff Report on or before June 4, 2002.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
5 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
