RE: STAFF REPORT FOR LUBBOCK RADIO PAGING SERVICES INC. DBA STENOCALL APPLICATION TO CANCEL A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR ALTERNATIVE OPERATOR SERVICES (DOCKET NO. T-02629A-01-0241)

On March 21, 2001, Lubbock Radio Paging Service Inc. dba Stenocall ("Applicant") filed an application to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"). The Applicant no longer provides alternative operator services ("AOS") in the State of Arizona. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Applicant's application be approved.

In its application, the Applicant indicated that its has done no business in Arizona since September 1999. The Applicant furnished evidence that it surrenders its authority to do business in the State of Arizona. The Applicant attached, as evidence, a copy of the Application for Withdrawal from the Arizona Corporation Commission Corporations Division and a copy of the Certificate of Compliance For Dissolution Or Withdrawal from the Arizona Department of Revenue to its application to cancel its CC&N.

Staff further recommends that the Applicant's CC&N be cancelled without a hearing. Upon cancellation of its CC&N, Lubbock Radio Paging Service Inc. dba Stenocall will not be authorized to provide AOS in Arizona and will not have to meet the requirements of Decision No. 58511.
