**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE
RATE AND FINANCING APPLICATION OF
ST. DAVID WATER ASSOCIATION**

On May 7, 2001 and on August 3, 2001, St. David Water Association ("Company") filed applications with the Arizona Corporation Commission for a 31 percent increase in water rates, and for financing approval, respectively. The actual percentage rate increase for individual customers will vary depending upon the type and quantity of service provided. Copies of the Company's applications and proposed tariffs are available at their offices and the Commission's offices for public inspection during regular business hours.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning January 31, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona. Public comments will be taken at the outset of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Companies or their counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of one of the Companies, a shareholder of one of the Companies, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Companies or their counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before January 22, 2002. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.

If you have any questions or concerns about this application or have any objections to its approval, or wish to make a statement in support of it, you may write the Consumer Services Section of the Commission at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 or call 1-800-222-7000 or appear at the hearing and make comment.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
