BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 18, 2005, Farmers Water Co. ("Farmers" or "Company") filed an Application for an Extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN" or "Certificate") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").

On December 16, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") notified the Company that its application was not sufficient pursuant to the Arizona Administrative Code.

Farmers provided additional documentation on March 30, 2006.

On April 27, 2006, Staff notified the Company that its application was sufficient.

Accordingly, the matter should be set for hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** in the above-captioned matter shall be held on **July 7, 2006, at 10:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, **Room 222**, 400 West Congress St., Tucson, Arizona 85701.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 27, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall serve public notice of the hearing in this matter, in the following form, type size and style:

On November 18, 2005, Farmers Water Company (Company”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”). If the application is granted the Company would be the exclusive provider of water service within the requested extension area, and would be required to provide service on the terms and conditions as established by the Commission.

The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and in Tucson, at 400 West Congress St. Suite 218, Tucson, Arizona and at the offices of the Applicant, [APPLICANT INSERT ADDRESS]. The application is also available on the Commission’s website, www.azcc.gov, using the e-Docket link.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter on **July 7, 2006 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission’s Tucson offices, **Room 222, 400 West Congress St., Tucson, Arizona 85701**. As a property owner or customer you may have the right to intervene in the proceeding. If you do not want to intervene, you may appear at the hearing and make a statement on your own behalf. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written notice to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Applicants or their counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenors interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicants, a shareholder or member of the Applicants, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **June 27, 2006**. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer’s own behalf. However, you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Company shall mail to its customers and the property
15 owners in the proposed extension area a copy of this notice by first-class U.S. Mail, to begin as soon
16 as possible and to be completed on or before **May 26, 2006**.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Company shall file certifications of mailing as soon as
18 practicable after the mailing has been completed.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing,
20 notwithstanding the failure of an individual customer to read or receive the notice.


21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file its **Staff Report** by **June 15, 2006**.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **responses** by the Company, if any, to Staff's Report shall
23 be filed no later than **June 28, 2006**.

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
25 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
27 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


