**JOINDER IN MOTION AND APPLICATION FOR
INTERVENTION OF WORLDCOM, INC.**

WorldCom, Inc., on behalf of its regulated subsidiaries, ("WCom") joins in the Motion for Suspension and for Hearing filed by Cox Arizona Telcom, L.L.C. ("Cox") in the above-referenced docket. WCom shares in the concerns raised by Cox in its Motion regarding Qwest's plans to allow its customers to place a local carrier freeze on their accounts and strongly concurs that action by the Arizona Corporation Commission is necessary given the state of competition in Arizona and the potential anticompetitive impact of such a freeze in the local market.

1 In addition, pursuant to Rule 14-3-105 of the Arizona Corporation Commission
2 Rules of Practice and Procedure, WCom applies to intervene in the above-captioned
3 proceeding and states the following:

4 1. Wcom, through its regulated subsidiaries, is certificated to provide local
5 exchange, intraexchange, and interexchange telecommunications services throughout the
6 State of Arizona.

7 2. WCom is both a customer and a competitor of Qwest for telecommunication
8 services in Arizona and is directly and substantially affected by Qwest's plan to allow its
9 customers to place local carrier freezes on their accounts.

10 3. WCom respectfully requests that its application to intervene be granted at this
11 time because WCom's participation in this proceeding will not unduly broaden the nature
12 or scope of this proceeding and will not delay the proceedings.


