PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 28, 2002, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed tariff revisions to give its customers the option of instituting a freeze of their local exchange provider.

On January 31, 2002, Cox Arizona Telecom, LLC ("Cox") filed an Application to Intervene. Cox has a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive resold and facilities-based local and long distance telecommunications services in Arizona. Cox also filed a Motion for Suspension and for Hearing. Cox requests the Commission conduct an evidentiary hearing to fully examine the propriety of the local service freeze and to determine if the tariff should be approved.

On February 4, 2002, WorldCom, Inc., on behalf of its regulated subsidiaries, ("WCom") filed a Joinder in Motion and Application for Intervention. Wcom, through its regulated subsidiaries, is certificated to provide local exchange, intraexchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona. WCom is both a customer and competitor of Qwest.

On February 4, 2002, Time Warner Telecom of Arizona, LLC ("TWTA") filed a Joinder in Motion and Application for Intervention. TWTA is certificated to provide telecommunications services in Arizona and is a customer and competitor of Qwest.


On February 7, 2002, Arizona Corporation Commission Staff ("Staff") has recommended that the matter be suspended for 120 days. Staff's recommendation is scheduled to be considered at the Commission's regular Open Meeting on February 26 and 27, 2002.

No party opposed the requests for intervention. Cox, WCom and TWTA have alleged sufficient basis for intervention, and their applications should be granted.

1 The request for hearing is taken under advisement pending the Commission's action on the
2 recommended suspension. It is anticipated that a procedural conference will be convened shortly
3 after the Commission takes action on the suspension request.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applications to Intervene by Cox, WCom and
5 TWTA are hereby granted.


