

STAFF'S NOTICE OF ERRATA - SUPPLEMENTAL EXHIBIT

Staff of the Utilities Division ("Staff") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") hereby submits an amended version of a table submitted as part of the Staff Report admitted as Exhibit S-1 during the evidentiary hearing. The purpose of the amended version of the table is to correct an arithmetic error made in determining the percentage increases for the LPS (>69kv) customer rate class under the Settlement versus worst and best case scenarios as described in

1 the Staff Report on page 40. Those percentage increases for the LPS(>69kv) customer rate class are  
2 36% under the Settlement Agreement versus 62% and 44% under the worst and best cases  
3 respectively. The figures for all of the other customer rate classes remain constant. Staff would  
4 respectfully request that this amended table be substituted for the chart included in the Staff Report  
5 or, in the alternative, that this table be a late-filed exhibit.
