PROCEDURAL ORDER

14 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

15 On April 14, 2006, Eschelon Telecom of Arizona, Inc. ("Eschelon") filed with the Arizona
16 Corporation Commission ("Commission") a complaint against Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") stating
17 that Qwest has refused to provide both repairs for disconnects in error and the capability to expedite
18 orders for unbundled loops under the repair and expedite language of the Qwest-Eschelon
19 Interconnection Agreement ("ICA").

20 On April 27, 2006, Qwest and Eschelon filed an Agreement of Parties for Extension of Time
21 to Answer the Complaint in this matter, giving Qwest until May 12, 2006 to file its Answer.

22 On May 12, 2006, Qwest filed its Answer to Eschelon's Complaint.

23 Accordingly, a procedural conference should be scheduled.

24 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **procedural conference** shall be scheduled on **May**
25 **24, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 33 (c) and (d) of the
27 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

28 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the

1 Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at
2 all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
3 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
4 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
