Dear ACC Commissioners:

As your secret spy in Golden Valley, I'm sending you some photos I've just taken minutes ago. They show the callous manner in which James Rhodes and subcontractors treat the local residents.

I apologize ahead of time for the download time necessary to transmit these pictures to you but I feel they are of vital concern to the Perkins Mountain Water Company refusal that is so needed locally in our part of Mohave County.

These photos show how Rhodes has blocked access to Quartzite at Ramada in Golden Valley. This is the second day of such road blocks and they are scheduled to remain for the rest of this week according to the Layne crew on the job.

During that week, we will be treated to a massive waste of fresh usable groundwater that they have deliberately diverted into Quartzite turning that major cross street into an impassable river. Just last night, quite late, a big truck got stuck in it up to the axle and had to call in a heavy-duty towing vehicle to pull it out of the river that is otherwise a county street and so clearly marked by the street signs in the photos.


The photos show the approach, down Ramada, from both directions to the elevated road block at Quartzite that is almost impassable by smaller vehicles. Please note there is no warning about this road block posted anywhere. There are no reflectors or lights on the two sawhorse barricades marking its location. It could cause serious damage to vehicles and occupants. The local county highway and streets dept. won't return phone calls on the subject and are apparently ignoring Rhodes' ongoing work and the inconvenience it's causing the local residents who are now into the fourth month of listening to those generators and heavy machines clanking away and kicking up clouds of dust up and down our residential streets.


Shown also is the outlet from Golden Valley Well #3 as it pours directly into the county street and runs for well over a mile away from the wellsite itself.


I took a number of other photos also, but am not sending them because of the download time involved. Should you want any of them for any reason, please don't hesitate to ask me to send them along to you.
