This is regarding the James Rhodes/Perkins Mountain Water Company ongoing investigation. It is being written primarily to the Commissioners of the Arizona Corporation Commission as an addition to my last email message to them. That message, two weeks ago, told of Rhodes'

Golden Valley well #3 at the corner of Ramada and Quartzite in Golden Valley and had attached to it photographs taken that day of the extensive water damage caused to Quartzite as well as the road block barricade of Ramada.

This time I am also sending copies to the Mohave County Board of Supervisors. This is particularly true for Tom Sockwell, who needs to help protect Golden Valley and the citizens a bit more than he usually does.

It is also being sent to Gary Conter of Mohave County Public Works. We wish to thank Mr. Conter for meeting with three very upset and inconvenienced neighbors at the well site today and listening patiently to our complaints about the damages and other tangible losses we have suffered because of Rhodes' activities in the four months that this well site has been operating...usually 24/7 that makes for restful nights with all that heavy equipment running up and down the street (Ramada) the one and a half miles to Rhodes' Golden Valley Ranch.

At Mr. Conter's request I am attaching to this message three photographs taken today just before noon. These pictures show the damage to Quartzite and the existing roadblock and large pipes STILL blocking the county streets. You will note that Quartzite is completely impassable for at least one mile. Additional pictures taken today are available on request.

Since this work site has now been empty and without activity for well over a week. We're wondering when the barricade will be removed and when Quartzite will be restored.

There is unfortunately one huge intangible that must be mentioned; the attitude of the Rhodes "consultants" across the board as presented to us, the citizens of Golden Valley. The "geologist consultant" who occasionally visits this well site is a case in point. His name is not known (tall, thin, big moustache, straw hat [be on the lookout for him]) but he is a prime example. Rarely does one encounter a person so contemptuous of everything surrounding them. He gets right in your face and says, roughly translated, "F*** off! I can do anything I want to and you can't do anything about it." This follows exactly James Rhodes' No.

1 business ethic, "screw them before they screw me."

This is not a person we would want as a neighbor. This is obviously much more important to the current local taxpaying citizens than it is to the grand and glorious future megamob

promised by Rhodes' hype. Will one of you please take a moment to remember us in passing?
