PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 5, 2005, Arizona Water Company ("AWC" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N").

On December 23, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a sufficiency letter.

On January 4, 2006, a Procedural Order was issued in this docket setting forth a hearing date and filing deadlines.

On January 20, 2006, AWC filed its Certificate of Notice indicating that it published notice as ordered by the January 4, 2006, Procedural Order.

On February 21, 2006, Staff filed its Staff Report.

On February 23, 2006, Montezuma Rimrock Water Co., LLC ("Montezuma") filed an Application to Intervene.

On March 3, 2006, AWC filed its Response to Staff Report.

On March 6, 2006, Montezuma was granted intervention by Procedural Order.

On March 21, 2006, the hearing was held as scheduled. At hearing, testimony was given regarding AWC's agreement with the developer of Beaver Creek Preserve, which has requested water service of the Applicant. Specifically, testimony was given that, if the CC&N extension is granted, AWC would provide water to a master meter within the development of Beaver Creek Preserve, and water service, individual meters and billing within the development would be

1 administered by the Beaver Creek Wastewater Improvement District.

2 Based on this new information, on March 22, 2006, by Procedural Order, Staff was ordered to
3 file an update or addendum to its Staff Report by April 20, 2006, and Applicant was ordered to file a
4 response to the Staff Report by May 4, 2006.

5 On April 20, 2006, Staff filed an addendum to its Staff Report.

6 On April 28, 2006, AWC filed a request to extend the deadline for Applicant and Montezuma
7 to file a response to the addendum to Staff Report. AWC indicated in its filing that Montezuma and
8 Staff have no objection to this request. This request was granted by procedural order on May 1,
9 2006.

10 On May 16, 2006, AWC filed a Motion for Procedural Order to Extend Time requesting until
11 June 21, 2006 to file responses to Staff's addendum to Staff Report. AWC indicated that Staff has no
12 objection to the request and that it has been unsuccessful in its attempts to contact Montezuma.
13 AWC's request is reasonable and should be granted.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that responses by the Applicant and Montezuma, if any, to
15 Staff's April 20, 2006 addendum to Staff Report shall be filed no later than June 21, 2006.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter continues to be suspended.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
18 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
20 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
21 hearing.


