PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 8, 2006, Gold Canyon Sewer Company ("Gold Canyon" or "Applicant"), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate" or "CC&N") in Pinal County, Arizona.

On April 21, 2006, Staff filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket indicating that the Applicant's application has met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code.

On April 25, 2006, by Procedural Order, filing deadlines and a hearing were scheduled.

On May 11, 2006, Staff filed a request for an extension to file its Staff Report which was originally scheduled to be filed on or before May 15, 2006. Staff stated that Applicant had no objection to this request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Staff Report in this matter shall be filed on or before May 22, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any objections to the Staff Report shall be filed on or before June 9, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before May 29, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any objections to Motions to Intervene must be filed within 10 days, but no later than June 12, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other deadlines set forth in the April 25, 2006

1 Procedural Order shall remain in full force and effect.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
3 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
5 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
6 ruling at hearing.


