MOTION FOR PROCEDURAL ORDER TO
EXTEND TIME

Arizona Water Company (the "Company") hereby applies for an extension, from May 17, 2006 to June 21, 2006 of the filing date for responses by the Company and the Intervenor, if the Intervenor has any, to the Staff's update to its Staff Report, as filed on April 20, 2006.

The Company submits that good cause exists for this extension. As noted in its April 28, 2006 request for an extension, which was granted in a May 1, 2006 procedural order, in its update the Staff modified one of its recommendations concerning the expansion of the Company's certificate of convenience and necessity with respect to Parcel 1 as identified in the Company's application. This change in the Staff's recommendation has resulted in the Company's reassessment of some its plans for serving Parcel 1. This reassessment, in turn, has involved discussions between the Company, the Staff, and counsel for the Beaver Creek Domestic Water Improvement District, the latest of which occurred in a May 15, 2006 conference call, in which the Company, the Staff and counsel for the District agreed that additional time is necessary

1 for the Company to address its concerns, and Staff's concerns, with respect to water
2 service for Parcel 1 of the proposed extension.

3 Staff Counsel has indicated that he has no objection to this request. The
4 Company has attempted to contact the Intervenor, but has not been able to do so.
5 However, the Intervenor did not object to the Company's April 28, 2006 request and,
6 because the Intervenor informed the Company that it has no interest in Parcel 1, the
7 Company believes that the Intervenor would not object to its request herein.

9 The Company respectfully requests the entry of a Procedural Order
10 approving its request to extend the foregoing filing deadline to June 21, 2006.
