PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 15, 2005, Green Acres Water, L.L.C. ("GAW") and Green Acres Sewer, L.L.C. ("GAS") (collectively "Applicants") each filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide public water and wastewater utility service, respectively, to various parts of Maricopa County, Arizona..

On December 9, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued a notice of insufficiency which indicated that GAW's and GAS' applications had not met the sufficiency requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-411(C) and A.A.C. R14-2-610(C).

On March 1, 2006, Staff filed a Motion to Consolidate ("Motion") the above-referenced matters which are substantially related without objection by Applicants.

On March 2, 2006, by Procedural Order, the proceedings were consolidated.

On May 8, 2006, Staff issued a letter of administrative completeness to GAW and GAS.

On May 11, 2006, by Procedural Order, a hearing was set in this matter and filing deadlines were established for various documents including the Staff Report, which was due to be filed on June 12, 2006.

On June 12, 2006, Staff filed a Request for an Extension of Time to file its Staff Report on

1 June 16, 2006.

2 The request is reasonable and should be granted.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Staff Report and associated exhibits to be presented  
4 at hearing on behalf of Staff shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before 4:00 p.m. on June 16,  
5 2006.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other filing deadlines set forth in the May 11, 2006,  
7 Procedural Order shall remain the same.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,  
9 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by  
10 ruling at hearing.
