PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 5, 2006, the Union Pacific Railroad Company ("Railroad") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a request for approval for the Railroad to construct a second set of tracks at the existing crossings at Fortuna and Blaisdell Roads, Yuma County, Arizona, at AAR/DOT Nos. 753 584A and 742 055L, respectively.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the request of the Railroad shall be considered an application for the Railroad to upgrade existing crossings pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-337, et seq.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Railroad shall be considered as the Applicant in this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **hearing** on the application shall be held on **July 13, 2006, at 10:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within five business days of receipt of this Procedural Order, the Union Pacific Railroad Company shall provide Yuma County, the City of Yuma and any other municipality or interested party that may be affected by the application with a copy of the application and this Procedural Order by certified mail.
