PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE APPLICATION OF QWEST COMMUNICATIONS INTERNATIONAL, INC., QWEST SERVICES CORPORATION AND QWEST CORPORATION FOR WAIVER OR APPROVAL OF THE SALE OF THE ARIZONA OPERATIONS OF QWEST, INC. DOCKET NO. T-01051B-02-0666.

On August 30, 2002, Qwest Communications International, Inc., Qwest Services Corporation and Qwest Corporation (collectively "Qwest") filed a Notice with the Arizona Corporation Commission pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-800, A.A.C. R14-2-800 and A.A.C. R14-3-805 for the sale of its directory publishing assets in Arizona owned by Qwest, Inc. Qwest requests that the Commission declare that this transaction falls within the scope of the waiver granted in Commission Decision No. 50087, or the sale of directory assets is not subject to Commission regulation based on a 1999 Mountain Bell Settlement Agreement. Alternatively, Qwest requests in the Notice that the Commission waive compliance, in part, with the available market rules or approve the sale of Directory Assets, which are Qwest's Network Assets, at its office and the Commission's office for public inspection during regular business hours.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning on January 27, 2003 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's office, 1700 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment may be taken on the first day of the hearing. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Interventions shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Qwest or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the time it is filed, shall contain the Docket No. T-01051B-02-0666 and the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whose service of documents the intervenor is made; different intervenors may file different motions to intervene.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Qwest or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case).

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before April 15, 2003. The granting of interventions, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
