JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

Santa Cruz Water Company, LLC; Palo Verde Utilities Company, LLC; Global Water – Santa Cruz Water Company and Global Water – Palo Verde Utilities Company (collectively, “Global”) and Arizona Water Company (“AWC”) jointly move that the procedural conference currently scheduled for July 27, 2006 be rescheduled for August 16 or 17, 2006.

There are two reasons for the request. First, counsel for AWC has a previously scheduled trip that will cause him to be out of the state on July 27th. Second, the current schedule does not allow Global the normal time to file its replies. On June 30, 2006, Global filed a Motion to Dismiss, and separately filed a Motion to Vacate Consolidation. On July 17, 2006, AWC filed a

2 – several days after the procedural conference.² Rescheduling the procedural conference would
3 thus allow Global the normal and customary time to prepare its Replies. We have conferred
4 regarding our respective schedules and respectfully note that counsel will be available August 16
5 and 17, 2006. In addition, we are authorized to state that Staff does not object to the rescheduling
6 requested herein. Accordingly, Global and AWC request that the procedural conference currently
7 scheduled for July 27, 2006 be rescheduled for August 16 or August 17, 2006.
