**APPLICATION**

Looking Glass Networks, Inc. (“LGN” or “Applicant”) hereby respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order canceling LGN’s Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and, to the extent necessary, canceling LGN’s Arizona tariffs currently on file with the Commission.

LGN submits the following information in support of this Application:

1. LGN is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business located at 1111 West 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, Suite 600 Oak Brook Illinois 60523. LGN is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Looking Glass Networks Holding Co., Inc. (“LGN-Parent”). LGN does not currently have any affiliates that are providing telecommunications services in Arizona.

2. LGN was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity by the Commission’s Decision No. 63928 issued in Docket No. T-03903A-00-0511 on August 21, 2001 to provide competitive facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access, and interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona (the “Certificate”). LGN, however, does not currently provide, and has never provided, any services pursuant to the Certificate and has no current plans to provide any such services. LGN recognizes that should its business plans change in the future, LGN would need to re-apply for the requisite certificate(s).

3. Since LGN does not provide any intrastate telecommunications services in Arizona pursuant to its Certificate, no customers will be affected by the cancellation of LGN’s

certificate. In addition, any requirement to give prior written notice of LGN's surrender of its Certificate is inapplicable in this instance because LGN has no customers that receive intrastate service in Arizona. Nevertheless, LGN will publish notice of this Application in the appropriate newspapers and has provided a sample notice as Exhibit A.

4. To the extent necessary, LGN also withdraws and requests cancellation of its Arizona tariff currently on file with the Commission.

5. LGN submits that the surrender of its Certificate is reasonable, necessary and not disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity of the State of Arizona. In addition, LGN has never collected any advances, deposits and/or prepayment for intrastate services from any Arizona consumers.

6. Because no customers will be affected by the cancellation of LGN's certificate, LGN requests that the cancellation become effective immediately or as soon as the Commission can take any necessary administrative action.
