PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 29, 1998, Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. dba Phones For All ("Applicant") filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide local exchange services as a reseller within the State of Arizona. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1104 and R14-2-1105, Applicant is required to publish notice of its filing in newspapers in all counties where service is to be provided. Applicant filed Affidavits of Publication on July 20, 1998. On August 20, 1999, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter. In part, the Staff Report recommended that Applicant procure a performance bond or escrow account in an amount to cover 60 days revenue from its customers and any prepayments or deposits collected from its customers.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1106 and R14-2-1108, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant shall file written exceptions to the Staff Report or request that a hearing be set by October 29, 1999.

1 IT IS FUTURE ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-2-105,
2 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before October 29, 1999.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following notice shall be provided to the organizations

9 Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. dba Phones For All ("Applicant") has filed
10 with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a

12 exchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be
13 required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and
14 terms and conditions established by the Commission.

15 A.R.S. § 40-282 provides that the Commission may act on an application for

17 a hearing, if one is requested by any party. Applicant or any other party must request
18 a hearing by October 29, 1999, or the Commission will rule on the application

26 A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before
27 October 29, 1999. You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding, or you


12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice in accordance with this Procedural Order shall be


